





UV Science - Classification To introduce the topic, UV enjoyed working practically to classify Liquorice Allsorts. After discussing scientific language, focusing on properties of materials, and the importance of using closed questions to structure their classification, the children created a branching key using a variety of animals. Well done!



Blue Class Science - Being a Geologist Blue enjoyed classifying a variety of different sweets that represented the properties of a range of rocks. They enjoyed testing these and learning geological words:

Cleavage (how a rock breaks along a layer); Streak (the colour a rock makes when scratched); Lustre (how the rock reflects light); Crystalline (has crystals) and Friable (any rock that easily crumbles). We also discussed Friedrich Moh's scale of hardness with his 'Scratch test.' Well done!
